## Canine education

**Methods based on canine psychology and behaviour**

**8-week courses begin on Thursday, September 13, 2007**

**Classes limited to 6 to 8 dogs**

**Minimum age requirement: 4 months. Vaccines must be to date.**

### **Level 1 :**

- 10 points evaluation of each dog registered
- basic canine hygiene : dental, ears and nails
- general information to help you solve day-to-day behavioural problems
- introduction to walking on leash and basic commands : sit, down, come and stay
- games

### **Level 2 :**

- perfecting walking on leash and basic commands : sit, down, come and stay
- stand for examination
- recalls from a distance
- out-of-sight stays
- introduction to off-leash walking
- possibility to obtain a CKC « Canine Good Citizen » certificate
